
Hayfield baby mitt and bootee booklet B PAIRS OF BOOTEES, 4 PAIRS OF MITTS, IN VARIOUS YARNS

VERY IMPORTANT.—Tension is the most important element in knitting. If your tension is correct the garment will be the size indicated in the instructions. If necessary change to thicker or thinner needles to maintain the correct number of stitches and rows to the inch.

CASTING ON

Cast on using cable method. Using two needles. Make a loop and slip it on to left-hand needle (1 stitch made), insert needle through front of stitch, draw loop through and place on left-hand needle (2 stitches). * Insert needle through space between 2 stitches, yarn round, pull loop through and place on needle (3 stitches). Repeat from *.

INSTRUCTIONS ARE GIVEN FOR THE SMALLEST SIZE, CHANGES FOR OTHER SIZES, WHERE APPLICABLE, ARE GIVEN IN BRACKETS.

THE CAP

INSTRUCTIONS are given for a 12 inch size. Changes for 13, 14 and 15 inch sizes are given in brackets. MATERIALS

HAYFIELD BABY QUICK KNIT, 2 ozs.

1 pair each of No. 12 and No. 10 knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

MEASUREMENTS

At brim edge 12 (13:14:15) inches.

8 stitches to 1 inch on No. 10 needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

ABBREVIATIONS as on page 2.

Using No. 12 needles cast on 97 (105: 113: 121) sts. 1st row.—K.1, [P.1, K.1] to end.

2nd row.—P.1, [K.1, P.1] to end.

Rep. last 2 rows for $1\frac{1}{2}$ ($1\frac{1}{2}$: 2: 2) ins., ending with 2nd row.

Change to No. 10 needles and pattern.

1st row.—K.2, [Sl.1, K.3] to last 3 sts., Sl.1, K.2. 2nd row.—Knit.

Rep. these 2 rows for 4 $(4\frac{1}{2}:5:5\frac{1}{2})$ ins.

Shape Crown

1st row.—K.2, * Sl.1, K.1, K.2 tog., Sl.1, K.3, rep. from * to last 7 sts., Sl.1, K.1, K.2 tog., Sl.1, K.2.

2nd row.—Knit. 3rd row.—K.2, * Sl.1, K.2, Sl.1, K.3, rep. from * to last 6 sts., Sl.1, K.2, Sl.1, K.2.

4th row.-Knit.

Rep. last 2 rows twice more.

9th row.—K.2, * Sl.1, K.2, Sl.1, K.1, K.2 tog., rep. from * to last 6 sts., Sl.1, K.2, Sl.1, K.2.

10th row.-Knit.

11th row.—[K.2, Sl.1] to last 2 sts., K.2.

12th row.—Knit.

Rep. last 2 rows twice more. 17th row.—* K.2, Sl.1, K.2 tog., Sl.1, rep. from * to last 2 sts., K.2.

1000

18th row.—Knit.

19th row.-* K.2, Sl.1, K.1, Sl.1, rep. from * to last 2 sts., K.2.

20th row.—Knit.

Rep. last 2 rows twice more.

25th row.-* K.2 tog., Sl.1, K.1, Sl.1, rep. from * to last 2 sts., K.2 tog.

26th row.—Knit. 27th row.—[K.1, Sl.1] to last stitch, K.1.

28th row.—Knit.

29th row.—K.2 tog. to last stitch, K.1.

30th row.—As 29th row. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Sew sides together. Make a merous 3 inch tassel and secure to centre of crown.

THE BOOTEES (A)

MATERIALS

HAYFIELD BABYKIN or 3-ply BABY KNITTING BRI-NYLON, small amount.

1 pair of No. 12 knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension. A length of baby ribbon.

MEASUREMENTS

Length of sole 4 inches.

 $8\frac{1}{2}$ stitches to 1 inch on No. 12 needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

ABBREVIATIONS as on page 2.

Cast on 41 sts. and work 5 rows in m.-st.

Beg. patt. thus:

1st row.—K.2, * M.1, K.2 tog. t.b.l., K.3, rep. from * to last 4 sts., M.1, K.2 tog. t.b.l., K.2.

2nd row.—Purl.

3rd row.-* K.1, [M.1, K.2 tog.] twice, rep. from * to last st., K.1.

4th row.—Purl.

5th row.—As first row.

6th row.—Purl.

Beg. with a K. row cont. in st.-st. until work measures 2 ins., ending with a P. row.

Next row.-K.1, * M.1, K.2 tog., rep. from * to end. P. 1 row. Break yarn.

Sl. first and last 13 sts. on to spare needle.

Rejoin varn to centre 15 sts. and with right side facing work in st.-st. for $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins. Break yarn.

With right side facing pick up 13 sts. from first spare needle, 15 sts. from side of instep, 15 sts. from instep, 15 sts. from other side of instep, and 13 sts. from 2nd spare needle — 71 sts.

Work 11 rows in g.-st.

Next row.—K.2 tog., K.31, K.2 tog., K.1, K.2 tog.,

K.31, K.2 tog. Next row.—K.2 tog., K.29, K.2 tog., K.1, K.2 tog.,

K.29, K.2 tog. Cont. dec. in this way on every row until 6 dec. rows

in all have been worked. Cast off. Make other bootee to correspond.

Press gently, join seam. Thread ribbon through holes at ankle.

THE BOOTEES (B)

MATERIALS

HAYFIELD BABYKIN or 3-ply BABY KNITTING BRI-NYLON, small amount.

1 pair of No. 11 knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension. A length of ribbon.

MEASUREMENTS

Length of sole 4 inches.

8 stitches to 1 inch on No. 11 needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

ABBREVIATIONS as on page 2.

Cast on 41 sts. and K. 2 rows.

Beg. patt.

1st row.-* K.1, K.3 tog., [M.1, K.1] 3 times, M.1, K.3 tog., rep. from * to last st., K.1.

2nd row.—Knit.

3rd row.-Knit.

4th row.—Purl.

These 4 rows form the patt. Rep. them 5 times more. Next row.—K.1, * M.1, K.2 tog., rep from * to last

P. 1 row. Break yarn.

Sl. first and last 14 sts. on to spare needle, rejoin yarn to centre 13 sts. and, with right side facing, work 30 rows in g.-st. Break yarn.

With right side facing, K. up 14 sts. from first spare needle, 17 sts. from one side of instep, 13 sts. of instep, 17 sts. from other side of instep and 14 sts. from 2nd spare needle — 75 sts.

Work 11 rows in g.-st.

Next row.—K.2 tog., K.28, K.2 tog., K.11, K.2 tog., K.28, K.2 tog.

Next row.—K.2 tog., K.27, K.2 tog., K.9, K.2 tog., K.27, K.2 tog.

Cont. dec. in this way on every row until 6 dec. rows in all have been worked. Cast off.

Make other bootee to correspond.

TO MAKE UP

Press gently. Join seam. Thread ribbon through holes at ankle.

THE BOOTEES AND MITTS (C and K)

MATERIALS

HAYFIELD BEAULON BABY QUICK KNIT, or any Hayfield Baby Quick Knit, 2 ozs. 1 pair of No. 11 knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

MEASUREMENTS

The Mitts: Length at centre 4 inches. The Bootees: Length of sole $3\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

5½ stitches to 1 inch on No. 11 needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

ABBREVIATIONS as on page 2.

THE MITTS

Cast on 32 sts. and work 2 rows in g.-st.

Cont. in patt. thus:

1st to 5th rows.—Knit. 6th row.—K.1, * M.1, K.2 tog., rep. from * to last st., K.1.

These 6 rows form the patt.

Cont. in patt. until work measures 4 ins., ending with 6th row of patt.

K. 1 row.

Next row.—K.2, * K.2 tog., K.1, rep. from * to end. K. 1 row.

Next row.—K.2 tog. across all sts.

Next row.—K.2 tog. across all sts. to last st., K.1. Break yarn, thread through rem. sts., draw up and fasten off.

Make other mitt to correspond.

TO MAKE UP

Press gently. Join side seam. Make cords and thread through holes at wrist,

THE BOOTEES

done 2 patt

Cast on 32 sts. and work 2 rows in g.-st.

Cont. in patt. as for mitts until 4 complete patts. have been worked.

K. 2 rows. Break yarn.

Sl.11 sts. from each end of needle on to safety pins. Work 14 rows in patt. on centre 10 sts. Break varn. With right side facing pick up 11 sts. from first pin, 12 sts. along side of instep, 10 sts. from instep, 12 sts. along other side of instep and 11 sts. from 2nd pin.

Work 6 rows in g.-st. on these 56 sts.

Next row.—[K.2 tog., K.24, K.2 tog.] twice. Next row.—[K.2 tog. K.22, K.2 tog.] twice. Next row.—[K.2 tog., K.20, K.2 tog.] twice.

Cont. dec. thus in every row until 6 dec. rows in all have been worked. Cast off.

Make other bootee to correspond.

TO MAKE UP

Press gently. Join seam of bootees.

Make cords and thread through holes at ankles.

THE BABY SLIPPERS (D)

MATERIALS

HAYFIELD BABYKIN or 3-ply BABY KNITTING BRI-NYLON, small amount.

1 pair of No. 12 knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension. 4 buttons.

MEASUREMENTS

Length of sole 4 inches.

TENSION

8 stitches to 1 inch on No. 12 needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

ABBREVIATIONS as on page 2.

THE SOLE

Cast on 22 sts. and, working in g.-st. throughout, inc. 1 st. each end of every alt. row until there are 38 sts.

Dec. 1 st. each end of every alt. row until 22 sts. rem.

Shape Heel

Cast on 8 sts. at beg. of next row.

Keeping heel edge straight, inc. 1 st. at toe edge on every alt. row until there are 38 sts. on needle, ending at heel edge.

Cast off 20 sts. at beg. of next row, work to end.

K. 17 rows on rem. 18 sts.

Cast on 20 sts. at beg. of next row.

Keeping heel edge straight, dec. 1 st. at toe edge on every alt. row until 30 sts. rem. Cast off.

Join the two straight edges of heel. Join edges together round sole, easing fullness at toe.

The Strap

With right side facing pick up 18 sts. at heel [9 sts. each side of seam.

Cast on 14 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.

K. 3 rows.

Make buttonhole in next row thus: K.3, K.2 tog., M.1, K. to end.

K. 3 rows. Cast off.

Make other bootee to match, reversing buttonhole.

TO MAKE UP

Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes, sew other button on front of instep.

THE BOOTEES (E)

MATERIALS

HAYFIELD BABYKIN or 3-ply BABY KNITTING BRI-NYLON, small amount. 1 pair each of No. 13 and No. 12 knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension. A length of baby ribbon.

MEASUREMENTS

Length of sole 4 inches.

8½ stitches to 1 inch on No. 12 needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

ABBREVIATIONS as on page 2.

Using No. 13 needles cast on 44 sts. and work in K.1, P.1 rib for 1 inch.

Change to No. 12 needles.

Next row.-K.1, * M.1, K.2 tog., rep. from * to last st., P.1.

Next row.—Purl. Next row.—K.29 sts., turn, P.14 sts., turn, leave 15 sts. each side on spare needles.

Cont. in st.-st. on centre 14 sts. for 26 rows. Break varn.

With right side facing, K. across 15 sts. on first spare needle, pick up 18 sts. from side of instep, K. across centre 14 sts., pick up 18 sts. from other side of instep and K. across 15 sts. on 2nd spare needle - 80 sts.

Beg. with a P. row, work 11 rows in st.-st.

Next row.-* K.6, K. 2nd st. on left hand needle, then K. first, Sl. both sts. off needle tog., rep. from * to end. Beg. with a P. row work 3 rows more in st.-st. Cast off 33 sts. at beg, of next 2 rows.

Cont. in st.-st. on rem. sts. for $3\frac{1}{4}$ ins.

Dec. 1 st. each end of every alt. row until 6 sts. rem. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Press gently. Join back seam, join side edges of sole to cast-off edges of upper. Thread ribbon through holes at ankle.

Two Pairs of Bootees designed for Babykin or 3-ply Baby Knitting Bri-Nylon may be made from one ounce of either of these yarns.

THE BOOTEES (F)

MATERIALS

HAYFIELD BABYKIN or 3-ply BABY KNITTING BRI-NYLON, small amount.

1 pair each of No. 12 and No. 10 knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

MEASUREMENTS

Length of sole $3\frac{1}{2}$ (4) inches.

TENSION

 $8\frac{1}{2}$ stitches to 1 inch on No. 10 needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

ABBREVIATIONS as on page 2.

Using No. 12 needles cast on 40 (44) sts. and work 10 rows in K.1, P.1 rib.

Change to No. 10 needles and patt. thus:

1st row.—K.10 (12) sts., K. into front of 2nd st. on left hand needle, then K. first st., Sl. both sts. off needle tog., K. into back of 2nd st. on left hand needle then K. into front of first. Sl. both sts. off needle tog. [This will be called 'patt. 4']. K.4, patt. 4, K.4, patt. 4, K.10 (12) sts.

2nd row.-Purl.

Rep. these 2 rows 4 (5) times more.

Change to No. 12 needles and work 3 rows in K.1, P.1 rib.

Next row.—* K.1, P.1, M.1, P.2 tog., rep. from * to end.

Work 4 rows more in rib.

Next row.—K.18 (20) sts., patt. 4, K.4, turn, P.12, turn, leave rem. sts. on 2 spare needles.

Work 18 rows in patt. on these 12 sts. Break yarn.

Rejoin yarn at beg. of instep, K. up 11 sts. on one side of instep, K. across 12 sts. of instep, pick up 11 sts. from other side of instep, K. across rem. sts. on spare needle.

Next row.—Knit, pick up sts. from other spare needle. Work 12 (14) rows in g.-st.

Next row.—K.2, K.2 tog., K.20 (22) sts., K.2 tog., K.10, Sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.20 (22) sts., Sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.2.

K. 1 row.

Next row.—K.1, K.2 tog., K.19 (21) sts., K.2 tog., K.10, Sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.19 (21) sts., Sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1.

K. 1 row. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Join seam. Make cord and thread through holes at ankle. Make tassels for end.

THE MITTS (G)

MATERIALS

HAYFIELD BEAULON BABY QUICK KNIT, or any Hayfield Baby Quick Knit, 1 oz. 1 pair each of No. 10 and No. 8 knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension. A length of ribbon.

MEASUREMENTS

Length at centre $4\frac{1}{4}$ inches.

TENSION

5 stitches to 1 inch on No. 8 needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

ABBREVIATIONS as on page 2.

Using No. 10 needles cast on 28 sts. and K. 10 rows.

Next row.—* K.1, M.1, K.2 tog., rep. from * to last st., K.1.

P. 1 row.

Change to No. 8 needles and patt. thus:

1st row.—* K.3, K.2 tog., M.1, rep. from * to last 3 sts., K.3.

Rep. this row for the patt.

Work 23 rows more in patt.

K. 2 rows.

Next row.—K.2 tog., K.10, [K.2 tog.] twice, K.10, K.2 tog.

K. 1 row.

Next row.—K.2 tog., K.8, [K.2 tog.] twice, K.8, K.2 tog.

K. 1 row.

Next row.—K.2 tog., K.6, [K.2 tog.] twice, K.6, K.2 tog.

K. 1 row. Cast off.

Make other mitt to correspond.

TO MAKE UP

Press gently. Fold in half and join top and side seams. Thread ribbon through holes at wrist.



THE MITTS AND BOOTEES (H and J)

MATERIALS

HAYFIELD BEAULON BABY QUICK KNIT (or any Hayfield Baby Quick Knit), 2 ozs.

1 pair of No. 11 knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

MEASUREMENTS

Length of mitt $4\frac{1}{2}$ inches. Length of sole $3\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

5½ stitches to 1 inch on No. 11 needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

ABBREVIATIONS as on page 2.

THE MITTS

Cast on 33 sts. and work 6 rows in m.-st.

Next row.—K.2, * M.1, K.2 tog., K.1, rep. from * to last st., K.1.

P. 1 row.

Change to patt, thus:

1st row.-Knit.

2nd row.—Purl, winding yarn twice round needle on each stitch.

3rd row.—Knit, dropping all extra loops.

4th row.-Purl.

These 4 rows form the patt.

Cont. in patt. until work measures 4 ins., ending with 4th row of patt.

Next row.-* K.1, K.2 tog., rep. from * to end.

P. 1 row.

Next row.-* K.2 tog., rep. from * to end. P. 1 row.

Next row.-* K.2 tog., rep. from * to last st., K.1. Break yarn, thread through rem. sts., draw up and

fasten off.

Make other mitt to correspond.

TO MAKE UP

Press gently. Join side seam of mitts. Make cords to thread through holes at wrist.

THE BOOTEES

Cast on 35 sts. and work 6 rows in m.-st.

Cont. in patt. as for mitts until 3 complete patts. have been worked.

Next row.—* K.1, M.1, K.2 tog., rep. from * to last 2 sts., M.1, K.2 tog.

P. 1 row. Break yarn.

Sl.12 sts. each end of needle on to safety pins. Rejoin yarn to 11 sts. in centre and work 12 rows in patt., dec. 1 st. each end of last row. Break yarn.

With right side facing, pick up 12 sts. from first pin, 12 sts. from side of instep, 9 sts. of instep, 12 sts. from other side of instep, and 12 sts. from 2nd pin. Work 5 rows in m.-st. on these 57 sts.

Next row.-Work 2 tog., m.-st. 23, work 3 tog., m.-st.

1, work 3 tog., m.-st. 23, work 2 tog.

M.-st. 1 row. Next row.-Work 2 tog., m.-st. 20, work 3 tog., m.-st.

1, work 3 tog., m.-st. 20, work 2 tog. M.-st. 1 row.

Next row.—Work 2 tog., m.-st. 17, work 3 tog., m.-st.

1, work 3 tog., m.-st. 17, work 2 tog.

M.-st. 1 row. Cast off.

Make other bootee to correspond.

TO MAKE UP

Press gently. Join seam. Make cords and thread through holes-at ankles.

THE MITTS (L)

HAYFIELD BABY LEAF QUICK KNIT BRI-NYLON (or any Hayfield Baby Quick Knit), 1 oz. 1 pair each of No. 12 and No. 10 knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

MEASUREMENTS

Length at centre 5 inches.

TENSION

5 stitches to 1 inch over pattern on No. 10 needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

ABBREVIATIONS as on page 2.

Using No. 12 needles cast on 29 sts. and work in K.1, P.1 rib for 1 inch.

Change to No. 10 needles and patt. thus: 1st row.—* K.1, K.1 r.b., rep. from * to last st., K.1. 2nd row.-Knit.

3rd row.-* K.1 r.b., K.1, rep. from * to last st., K.1 r.b.

4th row.-Knit.

These 4 rows form the patt.

Cont. in patt. until work measures $4\frac{1}{2}$ ins., ending with a right side row.

Next row.-* K.1, P.2 tog., rep. from * to last 2 sts., K.1, P.1.

Next row.—* K.1, P.1, rep. from * to end.

Next row.—P.2 tog. to end of row.

Break yarn, thread through rem. sts., draw up and fasten off.

Make other mitt to correspond.

TO MAKE UP

Press gently. Join side seam.

THE TWO COLOUR BOOTEES (I)

MATERIALS

HAYFIELD BABYKIN or 3-ply BABY KNITTING BRI-NYLON, small amounts in main and contrast shade [may be made in one colour].

1 pair of No. 13 knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension. 2 buttons.

MEASUREMENTS

Length of foot $3\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

TENSION

9 stitches to 1 inch over stocking stitch on No. 13 needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

ABBREVIATIONS as on page 2.

Using No. 13 needles and C. cast on 45 sts. and work $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins. in K.1, P.1 rib.

Cont. in st.-st. until work measures $3\frac{1}{2}$ ins., ending with a wrong side row.

Break yarn, transfer the first 15 sts. to right hand needle, rejoin yarn, K.15 sts., turn, work 12 rows st.-st, on these 15 sts.

Change to M. and work 8 rows st.-st., dec. 1 st. each end of every alt. row. Break yarn.

Replace first 15 sts., using M., K.15 sts., K. up 13 sts. along first side of instep, K.7 sts. of instep, 13 sts. along other side of instep and rem. 15 sts., K. 13 rows on these 73 sts.

Shape Sole

1st row.—K.1, K.2 tog., K.26, K.2 tog., K.11, K.2 tog. K.26, K.2 tog., K.1.

2nd row.—K.1, K.2 tog., K.25, K.2 tog., K.9, K.2 tog. K.25, K.2 tog., K.1.

3rd row.—K.1, K.2 tog., K.24, K.2 tog., K.7, K.2 tog., K.24, K.2 tog., K.1.

4th row.—K.1, K.2 tog., K.23, K.2 tog., K.5, K.2 tog., K.23, K.2 tog., K.1.

5th row.—K.1, K.2 tog., K.22, K.2 tog., K.3, K.2 tog., K.22, K.2 tog., K.1.

6th row.—K.1, K.2 tog., K.21, K.2 tog., K.1, K.2 tog., K.21, K.2 tog., K.1.

Cast off rem. sts.

THE ANKLE STRAP

Using M., cast on 42 sts. and K. 2 rows.

Make buttonhole in next row thus: K.2, M.1, K.2 tog., K. to end.

K. 2 rows more. Cast off.

Make other bootee to correspond.

TO MAKE UP

Press gently. Join seam. Sew centre of ankle strap to back of heel, sew on button to correspond with buttonhole.

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
